January Saints

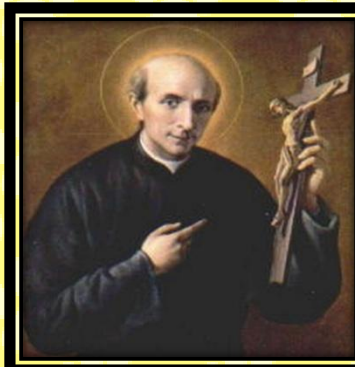
January 21st

The saint of the day is St. Agnes. She was a virgin and martyr slain with the sword at the age of 13 when she refused to turn against God. On her feast day two lambs are blessed at her church in Rome, Italy and then their wool is woven into bands of white wool which the pope presents to archbishops as symbol of their authority.



January 22nd

The saint of the day is St. Vincent. He was a Spanish deacon, tortured to death for the Catholic Faith in the fourth century. Today is also Pro-Life Day, a day of prayer & penance in the Catholic Church offered for the protection of all the unborn.



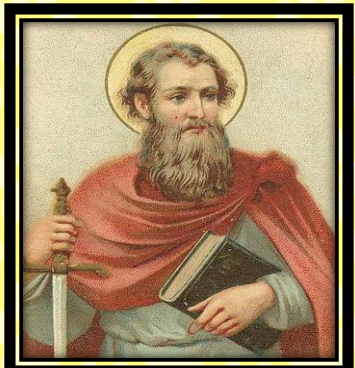
January 24th

The saint of the day is St. Francis de Sales. He was Bishop of Geneva and a Doctor of the Universal Church. In 1610 St. Francis was cofounder, with St. Jane Frances de Chantal, of the Order of Visitation Nuns. He converted 72,000 Calvinists to the Catholic Faith and died when he was only 55 years old. St. Francis de Sales is the patron saint of journalists.



January 25th

Today we celebrate the Conversion of St. Paul. Before his conversion, St. Paul the Apostle's name was Saul. He heard God's voice on the road to Damascus, where he was then baptized into the Catholic Faith by St. Ananias. He immediately began preaching in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God and changed his name from the Jewish Saul to a Gentile name, Paul.
